



Consumption of Fast Food by Australian Teenagers










Expenditure (Pence per person) on Fast Food, by Income Groups, UK 1990








Acid level in mouth from consumption of sugar/honey







Infant Mortality and Life Expectancy, 1970 - 1992















Students passing high school competency exams, by subject and gender, 2010-2011









Female unemployment rates in the four countries of the UK
























Reasons for most recent arrest (%)




